PARADE SAFETY RULES AND GUIDELINES



The parade will begin PROMPTLY at 6:00 pm on Friday December 5, 2025

- ALL PARADE ENTRIES MUST BE DECORATED AND LIT. We will no longer be accepting plain vehicles with just a company logo. This is a holiday parade, and your entry needs to be something your fellow community members are excited to see and experience.
- No entry can have more than one vehicle/truck/float (the only exception is a vehicle pulling a float on a flatbed).
- Parade registration is <u>not a guarantee</u> of acceptance to participate. The official parade committee will notify all registrants of their acceptance to participate.
- We will have an official Santa and Mrs. Clause in the parade. NO ENTREE IS PERMITTED TO HAVE A SANTA OR MRS. CLAUS IN THEIR ENTRY. We feel this is confusing to small children. If you have a santa on parade day, you will be asked to remove them from your entry.
- Check-in at registration at the Covelli Center Parking Lot, 229 E. Front Street.
 - Large floats & trucks (anything larger than a car) must be at Covelli **between noon and 4 pm**. Vehicles can be left and returned to later. All other entered cars/marchers must be at line-up no later than 5 pm. Final lineup will be at 5:30 pm.
- There will be no changes to final lineup except by Parade Officials.
- When registering, write a full description of entry for use by the announcer during the Parade. Include what type of vehicle/truck/float you will bring, number of walkers; length and width of vehicle/float; and description of candy or other items you will be handing out.
- Companies or organizations that will walk in the parade should carry a banner displaying the name of the group or company, and dress up or decorate themselves in a way that is festive. Banner carriers must be capable of maintaining the parade pace.
- All entries with animals will provide and use pooper-scoopers. Parade committee reserves the right to remove entry or entries that do not abide by this requirement. All animals must be on leashes.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages by drivers or any participants before or during parade is strictly forbidden.
- Autos and large vehicles must be driven by a licensed driver. Small vehicles (mini-bikes, small tractors, go-carts, etc.) must be operated by a person age 18 or older.
- Parade participants are not permitted to leave vehicles to demonstrate in any street or to stop or slow forward movement of the parade in any way.
- Throwing items such as gifts or candy during the parade is <u>prohibited</u>. This is to keep our children safe. <u>Candy</u> <u>must be handed out, so please have some walkers along the parade route if you wish to distribute</u> candy. No other items other than candy may distributed without approval by the Parade Committee.
- Parade officials will direct the disbanding.
